



## **KNOW BEFORE YOU GO: HELPFUL TIPS FOR YOUR VISIT TO *STAR WARS™ AND THE POWER OF COSTUME***

Here are some tips and guidelines to help you prepare for and enjoy your visit to the Museum of Fine Arts, St. Petersburg's exhibition *Star Wars™ and the Power of Costume*.

### **TICKETS**

Your exhibition ticket is good for one-time entry into the exhibition on the date and time printed on your ticket. Exhibition entry times do sell out, so advance ticket purchase is recommended to guarantee access to the exhibition. Members with member-discounted tickets should be prepared to present their Membership Card and Photo ID when checking in with Visitor and Member Services.

### **PARKING**

The Museum of Fine Arts offers valet parking off Beach Drive through our portico. Valet is \$10 per car for non-members, \$6 for Individual, Family, Dual, and Lifetime Members, and FREE for Patron Level Members of the Museum. Metered parking can be found along both Beach Drive and Bayshore Blvd. Additional parking is available in the Beach Drive Parking Lot.

### **BAGS/BACKPACKS**

For the safety and comfort of visitors and the protection of the objects, please store the following with our security team before entering the galleries:

- All backpacks

- Bags and purses larger than 13"x17"x8"
- Oversized/bulky coats
- Umbrellas

## **COSTUMES & ACCESSORIES**

Want to dress like your favorite character? We love it! However, please keep in mind that lightsabers and similar items are not allowed. Please leave all masks at home as they are not allowed on the museum grounds. A little bit of face paint is fine (e.g, a design around the eye or on a cheek), but full face paint is not allowed.

## **WHEELCHAIRS, STROLLERS, CANES, ETC**

The MFA strives to be accessible to everyone. Wheelchairs and strollers are welcome in the Museum and galleries. Wheelchairs may be borrowed from our security team. Scooters and motorized wheelchairs are also permitted, as are canes and walkers that convert to stools.

## **SKETCHING**

You are welcome to write or sketch with a graphite pencil in notebooks 11" x 14" or smaller. Please refrain from using ink pens or other writing utensils.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY**

We are a photography friendly museum, and photography without a flash for personal use is permitted. Please do not use tripods, monopods, selfie-stick, or similar equipment in the galleries. Please tag us in your photos with #StarWarsatMFA

## **FOOD & DRINK**

Please do not have any food or drink in the galleries. The MFA Café in the Mary Alice McClendon Conservatory is a great place to buy and enjoy delicious snacks, food, and drinks.
