- Be able to participate in group conversations
- Attend with their primary care partner
- Provide own transportation to the focus group

Arts experience or knowledge not required. Ability to articulate opinions freely and engage with others in a facilitated group conversation is highly desirable.

Respite care provided, if needed.

WHAT DOES THE STUDY INVOLVE?

We are facilitating two 90-minute small group discussions, each with 8 participants (4 pairs). Please note that all information will be kept confidential.
