# **GENERAL MUSEUM MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT**

All YPC members must hold an MFA membership at any level, such as:

- Individual \$75
- Dual \$125
- Family \$150
- Sustainer, Patron, or above for those wishing to further support the Museum

Any membership tier qualifies; individuals may choose the level that best reflects how they wish to engage with and support the MFA.
